- Must have the need, desire and proper attitude to work with Law Enforcement.

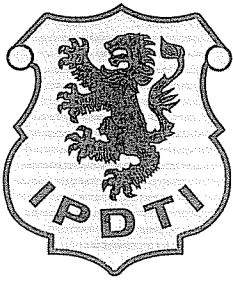
### **Active Law Enforcement / Correction / Security Officers**

- Must be at least 30 years of age.

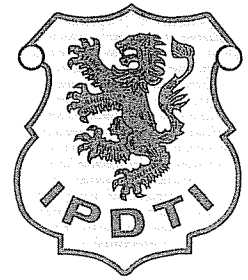

- Class size strictly **limited to 40 candidates**. We will accept registrations on a “first come-first served” basis.
- In case of overwhelming response, priority will be given to active **Law Enforcement Officers**. If you are not admitted to this session, the fee submitted will be immediately returned to you.

# International Police Defensive Tactics Institute



## IPDTI OVERVIEW

In today's World everyone should learn Self Defense and survival skills. However certain groups have exceptional requirements that must be addressed in a very specialized manner. One of those important groups is the Law Enforcement community. Members of this vast community which encompasses City, County, State and Federal Agencies as well as Correction, Military Police and the private security industry, have very specific needs in the area of Defensive Tactics, focusing primarily on controlling techniques, restraint and immobilization, weapon retention and disarming. And the technical material must be consistent with a philosophy that promotes safety and reduction of liability. Most "civilian Martial Arts" approaches to Police Defensive Tactics do not meet that challenge and may actually be incompatible with a Law Enforcement environment.

In 1997 John Pellegrini and a selected a group of his students, all with extensive Law Enforcement background and actual street experience, undertook research of existing Police Defensive Tactics courses and training methods, with the objective of developing a new program aimed at reducing officers' injuries, incidents of excessive force and charges of police brutality. The research revealed that both the injuries and the excessive force incidents were a direct result of insufficient or inadequate defensive tactics training.

Therefore, John Pellegrini, who during his 20 years in the Law Enforcement field and 40 years of Martial Arts experience had been a strong advocate of consistent, competent and intensive defensive tactics training for the Law Enforcement community, established the International Police Defensive Tactics Institute (IPDTI) with the following objectives:

- ~ To provide the most competent, effective and practical defensive tactics training.
- ~ To make officer's safety the foremost priority.
- ~ To prevent liability exposure for the officers and their department / agency.
- ~ To foster positive public relations for the Law Enforcement community by enhancing the professionalism and competence of individual officers.
- ~ To continue research and exchange in the field of Police Defensive Tactics.
- ~ To educate Martial Arts Instructors in the specific needs and requirements of the Law Enforcement community.

Today the International Police Defensive Tactics Institute (IPDTI) is recognized as one of the most professional and respected Law Enforcement training organizations in the World. We have instructed police, correction and security officers in the US, Puerto Rico, Canada, Germany, Italy, Finland, England, Bermuda, Ireland, Costa Rica, Spain, South Korea, Panama, Colombia, New Zealand and Japan.

The IPDTI basic 8 hour course (arrest & control techniques) is now certified by the California Commission on Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST). This certification (#1057-20995) was a landmark case because the IPDTI was the only non-law enforcement organization to be granted this prestigious accreditation. The IPDTI courses are also accredited by the Oklahoma Council on Law Enforcement Education & Training and the Minnesota Board of Peace Officer Standards and Training. Other states are in the process of reviewing and certifying our courses.

## IPDTI COURSES

IPDTI courses contain a wide range of unique realistic and effective techniques designed to deal with most situations and all kinds of resistance while remaining consistent with the “Force Continuum” Matrix.

The physical syllabus is hands-on and includes easy to learn and retain techniques covering blocks & strikes, joint locks & take-downs, pressure points, escorts, weapon retention, disarming of weapons, officer ground survival, tactical cuffing. All material is presented in a sound and humane legal context.

Currently the Institute offers two kinds of courses:

**Basic Defensive Tactics Course** (offered in some jurisdictions as a “Arrest & Control” course). This course consists of 8 hours of instruction conducted by HQ Staff Instructors or by a Licensed IPDTI Instructor in the area. A basic training certificate is issued to all participants who successfully complete the course.

**Instructor Licensing Course**. This course consists of 18 hours of training over a 3 day period and is conducted only by Institute HQ Staff. An IPDTI Instructor license valid for 3 years is issued to all participants who successfully complete the course. Re-certification by attending a 12 hour course is required every 3 years to maintain a valid license.
